

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Boone County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 A.M. and close at 8:00 P.M. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices.

Some races will not appear on the Primary Election ballot as the number of candidates filing for office does not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and will automatically advance to the November 6, 2018 General Election, when candidates for the Village Boards of Cedar Rapids, Petersburg and Primrose; Cornhusker Public Power District, Subdivision 3; Elkhorn Rural Public Power District, Subdivisions 1 & 3; Educational Service Unit No. 7, Districts 1 & 3; Educational Service Unit No. 8, Districts 3 & 5; and Educational Service Unit No. 10, District 1; may be elected.

Madison County
School District 0013
(Newman Grove Public Schools)
In the State of Nebraska**

“Shall Madison County School District 0013 (Newman Grove Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed Nine Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,500,000) for the purposes of financing the costs of constructing additions to and renovations of the District’s existing junior-senior high school building to create a single PK-12 school building, demolishing the District’s existing elementary school building, constructing a new vocational-agriculture building, acquiring necessary sites and constructing and installing site improvements related to such additions and building, and acquiring and installing necessary furniture, equipment and apparatus for such additions and building; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

“Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount

to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?”

Special Election
Albion Economic Development
Program Renewal**

“Shall the City of Albion establish an economic development program as described hereby appropriating twenty-five percent (25%) of the existing 1% local option sales and use tax revenues for a period of ten years beginning July 1, 2018?”

FOR the Albion Economic Development Program

AGAINST the Albion Economic Development Program

- a. The funds for the economic development program will be allocated from a portion of the current 1% sales and use tax. The funds will be appropriated for a ten year period (July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2028).
- b. The total amount to be collected for the Economic Development Program is estimated to be \$110,000 for each of the ten years. This total amount to be allocated for the Economic Development Program during the ten year period is estimated to be \$1,100,000.
- c. The City proposes, to be authorized, as and to the extent determined advisable by the Mayor and Council, to issue bonds pursuant to the Local Option

Municipal Economic Development Act to provide funds to carry out such economic development program.

- d. Additional funds from other non-city sources (such as Federal, State and private grants) may be sought beyond those derived from local sources of revenue.
- e. The goals of the Economic Development Plan are to:
 - 1) Create jobs through new business development.
 - 2) Assist existing business.
 - 3) Promote growth, stability, and progress in the Albion area.

If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of such program and allocation of tax, then the Mayor and Council of the City shall be empowered to allocate said future tax revenues for the purposes described within the question. If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such plan and allocation of tax, then the Mayor and Council of the City shall not allocate such tax revenues to the Economic Development Plan for the purposes described within the question.
