

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-32**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Nebraska Legislative Bill #5, which takes effect on September 1, 2009 allows for the trapping of animals in the County Road Right-of-Way, and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Nebraska Legislative Bill # 5, which takes effect on September 1, 2009 also allows for the County Board of Commissioners to pass a resolution to deny the right to trap in the County Road Right-of-Way, and

**WHEREAS**, the Boone County Commissioners feel it is in the best interest of Boone County not to allow indiscriminate trapping in Boone County Road Right-of-Way, and

**WHEREAS**, the Boone County Commissioners realize, that on occasion trapping of the Boone County Road Right-of-Way may be necessary to protect the traveling public from injury and Boone County Roads from damage

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Boone County Board of Commissioners that trapping will only be allowed by a licensed trapper, designated by the Boone County Board of Commissioners, on the rare occasion and as a last resort to minimize danger to the public or damage to a County Road. Any other person found trapping in the Boone County Right-of-Way without the specific permission of the Boone County Board of Commissioners, upon conviction could be fined a maximum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per trap.
