

PUBLIC HEARING PROCEEDINGS

2020 ONE AND SIX YEAR ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BOONE COUNTY, NEBRASKA

Larry Temme, Vice Chairman of the Boone County Board of Commissioners, called for a motion to open a public hearing on Monday, May 11, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. in the County Commissioners Meeting Room, Boone County Courthouse in Albion, Nebraska. Motion made by Commissioner Temme, second by Commissioner Rutten to open said public hearing. Commissioners present for said public hearing were Larry Temme and Ben Rutten. Commissioner Alan Rasmussen joined the public hearing by teleconference call/video conference. The State of Nebraska, Office of the Governor, issued Executive Order Number 20-03 Coronavirus Public Meetings Requirement Limited Waiver, shall apply to all public governing body meetings that occur March 17, 2020 through May 31, 2020. Stacey Ziemba, County Highway Superintendent, was present to answer the 2020 Road Improvement Program questions. Notice of the hearing was given in advance by publication and the convened hearing was open to the public.

The public hearing is for the purpose of hearing testimony in favor of, or opposition to, and to answer questions in relation to the proposed 2020 One and Six Year Road Improvement Program for Boone County, Nebraska. The hearing is to remain open for one hour.

Stacey Ziemba, Boone County Highway Superintendent, presented the 2020 One and Six Year Road Improvement Program for Boone County, Nebraska. The one-year road improvement plan consists of nine projects and the six-year plan consists of four projects. Ziemba prepared a map to use as a visual aid showing the location of the proposed projects. The Board received no opposition at the hearing.

The Board and Highway Superintendent reviewed and discussed each of the projects: One Year Projects – C-6(386; C-6(393); C-6(394); C-6(395); C-6(397); C-6(398); C-6(402); C-6(404); C-6(405); and Six Year Projects – C-6(359); C-6(390); C-6(392); C6(399). The plan serves as a guideline that can be amended if an unforeseen circumstance arises and needs immediate attention. Ziemba informed the Board that 2019 Projects C-6(391); C-6(400); C-6(366) were completed last year and C-6(401) was removed due to a bridge will not be built in said project area. In 2020 Projects C-6(404) and C-6(405) are newly added to the road improvement plan. The Board and Ziemba discussed the status of the asphalt (black top) roads that are in need of repair/resurfacing that have been discussed several times the past years with the County residents. The Board asked Ziemba to revise the road improvement plan to include the county asphalt (black top) roads.

Motion made by Temme, second by Rutten to close said hearing at 11:03 A.M. Roll call vote: Yeas: Temme, Rutten and Rasmussen. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion made by Rasmussen, second by Rutten to approve the 2020 One and Six Year Road Improvement Program for Boone County, Nebraska with the addition of the asphalt (black top) roads and the revised 2020 One and Six Year Road Improvement Program for Boone County, Nebraska is attached hereto as part of the proceedings. Roll call vote: Yeas: Rasmussen, Rutten and Temme. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Boone County 2020 One-and-Six-Year Plan

One Year Projects and Locations:

C-6(386): Replacement of an under 20' bridge with a CBC, T20N, R7W, NE qtr of Sec. 28 and NW qtr of Sec. 27; 190th Ave., north of 270th St.; \$70,000

C-6(393): Bridge 6(11215); remove existing bridge and install a CBC; T22N, R5W, between Sections 25 & 36; 150th St. east of 330th Ave.; \$160,000

C-6(394): Road Resurfacing; milling, resurfacing, shoulder work; T22N, R7W, Sections 26, 27, 28, 29; 145th St., 4 miles going west from 210th Ave. to 170th Ave.; \$3.6 million

C-6(395): Road improvement; dig ditch, build up road to increase drainage, remove trees; T19N, T18N, R8W, between Sections 33 & 4; 340th St. for ¾ mile going west from 130th Ave.; \$5,000

C-6(397): Culvert structure; tear out existing structure and replace with CBC; T19N, R7W, between Sections 17 & 20; 310th St. east of 175th Ave. ¼ mile.; \$70,000

C-6(398): Bridge 6(23340); tear out existing structure and replace CBC; T22N, R6W, Sections 10SE and 11SW; 260th Avenue, ¼ mile North of 120th Street; \$70,000

C-6(402): Road lower than ditches; need to dig ditches, build up road and add culverts; T20N, R8W, Sections SE qtr. 25 and NE qtr. 36; 270th Street going west for ¼ mile off 160th Avenue; \$25,000

C-6(404): Bridge 6(00405); remove existing wooden bridge deck, add sheet pile to existing pile in both abutments. Extend all 4 wings with new sheet pile, as needed and new H-piling. Raise new bridge deck 3', install new bridge caps. Install 15" concrete slots, widen bridge deck to 20.0', install new guardrail with W6" beams and galvanized guardrail with terminals; T22N, R8W, between sections 6 and 7; 110th Street west of 110th Avenue.; \$70,000

C-6(405): Remove and replace a 72" flat bottom CMP with a CBC; T21N, R6W, Sections 23-SE & 26-NE; 200th Street, west ¼ mile; \$160,000

Six Year Projects and Locations:

C-6(359): Bridge 6(00830); replace wooden structure with twin barrel CBC; T22N, R5W, between the SW qtr. Section 14 and the NW qtr. Section 23; 130th St.; \$90,000

C-6(390): Bridge 6(11815); replace wooden deck with pre-cast slab deck with W-Channel guard rails; T21N, R6W, NW qtr of Section 11 and NE qtr of Section 10; 180th St. east of 260th Ave.; \$80,000

C-6(392): 260th St. & Hwy 14 intersection,(Cargill Road); redo the intersection; T20N, R6W, beginning at Hwy 390 & Hwy 14, go east 0.43 miles along the NE qtr of Section 27 and the SE qtr of Section 22; 260th St.; \$308,000

C-6(399): Cattle pass, tear out existing cattle pass and replace with a new small CBC single barrel cattle pass; T21N, R5W, Sec 7SE; 180th Street, 2/3 mile west of 290th Avenue; \$60,000

C-6(406): Road Resurfacing; milling, resurfacing, shoulder work; T20N, R6W, NW qtr. of Section 21; between Highway 91 and 260th Street (Country Club Road) and between Highway 91 and 240th St and 260th Street (Fairgrounds Road), approximately 1 mile; \$800,000

C-6(407): Road Resurfacing; milling, resurfacing, shoulder work; T20N, R6W, SE qtr. Of Section 21; 260th Street, between Country Club Road and 11th Street; approximately ½ mile; \$400,000

C-6(408): Road resurfacing, milling, resurfacing, shoulder work; T20N, R6W, center of Section 27; 265th Street, between Highway Spur 6A and 6th Street; approximately 1 mile, \$800,000

C-6(409): Road Resurfacing; milling, resurfacing, shoulder work; 255th Avenue from Highway 91 going north to 210th Street; T20N, R6W, Sections 15 center, 10 center, 3 center NW qtr.: T21N, R6W, Section 34, center, approximately 4 miles; \$3.2 million

C-6(410): Road Resurfacing; milling, resurfacing, shoulder work; 220th Avenue between Highway 14 and Old Mill Road; T20N,R6W, Section 7 NW qtr. and Section 6 SW qtr. and NW qtr.; approximately 1.25 miles; \$875,000
